

PEST CONTROL COMPANION PLANTING CHART - new-self-sufficient-living.com

AMARANTH	Host to predatory ground beetle
ANISE	Host to predatory wasps which prey on aphids. deters pests from brassicas by camouflaging their odour
BASIL	Helps repel thrips flies and mosquitoes
BAY LEAF	Sprinkle dried leaves with other deterrent herbs (bay leaves, cayenne pepper, tansy and peppermint.) in the garden as a natural insecticide.
BORAGE	Deters tomato horn-worms and cabbage worms
BUCKWHEAT	The white blossoms attract beneficial insects that control aphids, mites and other pests. The beneficials it attracts include, hover flies, predatory wasps, pirate bugs, insidious flower bugs, tachinid flies and lady beetles.
CARAWAY	The flowers attract a number of beneficial insects especially the tiny parasitic wasps.
CATNIP	Deters flea beetles, aphids, Japanese beetles, squash bugs, ants, weevils and mice
CHAMOMILE	Host to beneficials - hover-flies and wasps
CHIVES	Help to keep aphids away from tomatoes, mums and sunflowers.
CHYRSANTHEMUMS	Kills root nematodes. It's flowers have been used as botanical pesticides for centuries. White flowering chrysanthemums repel Japanese beetles.
CLOVER	Attracts many beneficials. Useful planted around apple trees to attract predators of the woolly aphid. Clover inter-planted with cabbage has been shown to reduce the native cabbage aphid and cabbage-worm populations.
COMFREY	Good trap crop for slugs.
CORIANDER	Repels aphids, spider mites and potato beetle
COSTMARY	This 2-3 foot tall perennial helps to repel moths
DAHLIAS	Repels nematodes
DILL	Attracts hover-flies and predatory wasps. Repels aphids and spider mites to some degree
ELDERBERRY	A spray made from the leaves can be used against aphids, carrot root fly, cucumber beetles and peach tree borers. Put branches and leaves in mole runs to repel the moles.
FOUR O CLOCKS	POISONOUS USE WITH CAUTION IF YOU HAVE CHILDREN OR PETS! Draws Japanese beetles like a magnet. The foliage is pure poison to them and they die very quickly.
GARLIC	Repels moths, Japanese beetles, root maggots, snails, and carrot root fly. Concentrated garlic sprays help to repel and kill white-flies, aphids and fungus gnats
GERANIUM	Repels cabbage worms and Japanese beetles
GOPHER PURGE	Deters gophers and moles.
HEMP	Deters many kinds of beetles which attack brassicas
HORSERADISH	Deters Colorado potato bugs
HOREHOUND	Attracts many beneficial insects
HYSSOP	Repels cabbage moths and flea beetles.
LAMIUM	Repels potato bugs
LARKSPUR	Attracts and poisons Japanese Beetles
LAVENDER	Repels fleas and moths, whitefly and coddlin moth
LEEKs	Repel carrot flies

LEMON BALM	Sprinkled as a powder, this works to deter many bugs, including squash bugs.
LOVAGE	Provides good habitat for ground beetles which prey on other pests.
MARIGOLDS	Keeps soil free of nematodes, deters many insects. Attracts red spider mite and slugs
MINT	Deters white cabbage moths, ants, rodents, flea beetles, fleas, aphids and improves the health of cabbage and tomatoes
MOLE PLANT/CASTOR BEAN PLANT	POISONOUS! Deters moles and mice. Drop a seed of this in mole runs to drive them away
MORNING GLORIES	Attracts hover-flies which eat aphids
NASTURTIUMS	Deters aphids, squash bugs, and striped pumpkin beetles. Deters woolly aphids, white-flies, cucumber beetles and other pests of the cucurbit family
opal basil	May repel horn-worms
OREGANO	Plant near broccoli, cabbage and cauliflower to repel cabbage butterfly . Plant NEAR cucumbers to repel cucumber beetle
PARSLEY	Use as a tea to ward off asparagus beetles. Attracts hover-flies
PEPPERMINT	Repels white cabbage moth, aphids and flea beetles. Attracts bees and other beneficials
PETUNIAS	Repels the asparagus beetle, leaf-hoppers, some aphids, tomato worms, Mexican bean beetles and general garden pests
POACHED EGG PLANT	Attracts hover-flies which eat aphids
RADISH	Radishes may protect squash from squash borers. deter cucumber beetles and rust flies. Lure leaf-miners away from spinach
RHUBARB	Protects beans against black fly
RUE	Deters aphids, fish moths, flea beetle, onion maggot, slugs, snails, flies and Japanese beetles in roses and raspberries
SAGE	Deter cabbage moths, beetles, black flea beetles and carrot flies
SUMMER SAVOURY	Deters cabbage moths, Mexican bean beetles, sweet potato weevil and black aphids
SUNFLOWERS	Keep aphids under control
SWEET ALYSSUM	Attracts hover-flies whose larva devour aphids
TANSY	Deters flying insects, Japanese beetles, striped cucumber beetles, squash bugs, ants and mice
TARRAGON	Deters a wide variety of pests
THYME	Deters cabbage worms
WHITE GERANIUMS	Kills Japanese beetles
WORMWOOD	TOXIC TO ANIMALS! deters most insects
YARROW	attracts predatory wasps and ladybugs
ZINNIA	Attracts hummingbirds that eat white-flies
