

# Crocheted Headband with Knot

## Materials:

- Crochet Hook Size "I"
- 45 yards of yarn
- yarn needle

CH: Chain

SL: Slip Stitch

HDC: Half Double Crochet



**Row 1:** CH 10

**Row 2:** Starting 2nd CH from Hook, 8 HDC across, CH 2, turn

**Row 3:** 8HDC, CH 2, turn

Do all rows continuing this pattern. Measure by stretching headband to 30" wide

**Do not cut and finish.** Tie one big loose knot in what you just crocheted.

**To end:** SL ends together. Cut yarn and pull through to knot and weave in the ends with yarn needle. Work the large knot over the seam.

## Half Double Crochet:



Yarn over hook and insert into stitch (pic.1). Yarn over hook again and pull through stitch so that you have 3 loops on your hook (pic.2). Yarn over once more and pull through all 3 loops (pic.3). That is one half double crochet.
