Crocheted Ridge Headband with Button

Materials:


- Crochet Hook Size "I"
- 50 yards of yarn
- Button
- yarn needle

CH: Chain SL: Slip Stitch SC: Single Crochet

Row 1: Ch 11

Row 2: Starting @ 2nd CH from hook, 10 SC across CH 1, turn

Row 3: SC in back loop only (back of "V" makes the ridge), CH 1, turn Do all rows continuing this pattern



Measure by stretching headband to 22" (it really stretches)

To end: SL ends together to create band.

Finish off: Cut 2" and pull yarn through last stitch and weave in ends with yarn needle.

Adding Button: Thread remaining yarn through yarn needle to attach button to headband. Place your button off-center on your headband then sew your button to your headband. Lace through button holes and headband several times to secure. Knot yarn underneath headband and weave ends in. Cut off excess yarn if necessary.
