


Men's Wheelchair Bag Instructions

- 1. Using a running stitch, sew the pocket embellishment onto one of the large pockets as shown. Stitch around all edges of the pocket embellishment. (This "pocket" will be used as an embellishment only.)
- 2. Stich the button onto the center of the pocket embellishment.
- 3. Blanket Stitch the outer edges of the pockets on both sides as shown:
- 4. Thread parachute cord thorough casing. Tie slip knots at both ends of the cord.







Running Stitch Instructions:

To work the running stitch, insert your needle through the back side of the fabric at your starting point. Next, weave the needle in and out of the fabric, taking several evenly-spaced stitches. Pull the needle through and repeat to the end of the stitching area.

Blanket Stitch Instructions:

Push needle through both layers of felt about 1/4 inch in from the edge. Pass needle through the loop of thread created and pull taut, but not tight enough to pucker the fabric.

Make even stitches 1/4-inch apart (Refer to diagram at left for size)
