Fairy Wands with Tulle Instructions

Materials Needed:

- 8x8 inch piece of felt for 2 stars of equal size
- 81 inches of ribbon for 3 ribbons (Note: recommended width is between 3/8–5/8 inches wide). Ribbon should be the following lengths: 30 inches, 27 inches, and 24 inches.
- 1 button, preferably with two or four holes
- One 50-inch piece of crosheen (thread)
- 1 handful of batting
- 1 plastic wand
- 100 inches of tulle
- Scissors
- Needle



DO NOT CUT THE THREAD UNTIL THE LAST STEP IS FINISHED.

- 1. Thread the needle and knot the thread at the end. Set thread aside.
- 2. Take the longest ribbon and tie a bow in the center of it. Set aside.
- 3. Fold a piece of tulle in half and then in half again, making a small triangle. Insert the needle and thread though the point of the tulle. Repeat this step for each piece of tulle until they are all stacked on the thread.
- 4. Insert the needle through the center of the two ribbons, then the center of the bow, then the button, and push the needle back through all the layers of the ribbon and tulle.

Placement of button

- 5. Insert the needle through the center of one of the star. The thread should now be coming out of the back side of the star. DO NOT CUT THE THREAD.
- 6. Insert the needle on the back side of the star near the bottom inner corner. See arrow.
- 7. Place the second star against the back of the first star, placing the first stitch off-center at the bottom of the star and sew a running stitch near the edge of the two layers of the star, leaving the lower edge of the star unstitched (where you will insert the wand and batting). DO NOT CUT THE THREAD.
- 8. Stuff the batting into the star, pushing it into each corner, using the wand.
- 9. Bring the star and wand to a committee member, who will glue the wand to the star.
- 10. Finishing stitching the star. Make a knot at the edge of the star through both layers, where it meets the wand, and cut the thread. You're all done!
